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**Note: The mandatory disclosure in prescribed format is required to be hosted on the website as per directions in the AICTE website failing which, action would be initiated as per the rules and regulations of the AICTE including No Admission / Withdrawal of approval.**

The institution is required to submit two copies of the Compliance Report, indicating the rectification of deficiencies along with mandatory disclosure and details of faculty recruited for each course in the prescribed format (available at AICTE Website [www.aicteernet.in](http://www.aicteernet.in)) to the concerned Regional Office latest by 31<sup>st</sup> August-2009 for consideration of approval beyond the session 2009-10. **It may be noted that all the institutions are required to submit the Compliance Report alongwith requisite processing fee by 31<sup>st</sup> August every year irrespective of the period of approval.**

The Compliance Report must be accompanied with a processing fee of Rs. 50,000/- in the form of demand draft in the favour of Member Secretary, AICTE, payable at New Delhi. In the absence of processing fee the Compliance Report will not be entertained. Following the Compliance report, the Council would verify the status in respect of rectification of deficiencies through surprise random inspection without any prior notice.

The above approval if granted after rectification of deficiencies would be subject to the fulfilment of the following general conditions:

1. That the management shall provide adequate funds for development of land and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring expenditure.
2. (a) That the admission shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
- (b) That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations notified by the Council from time to time.
- (c) That the curriculum of the course, the procedure for evaluation/ assessment of students shall be in accordance with the norms prescribed by the AICTE.
- (d) That the Institution shall not allow closure of the Institution or discontinuation of the course(s) or start any new course(s) or alter intake capacity of seats without the prior approval of the Council.
- (e) That no excess admission shall be made by the Institution over and above the approved intake under any circumstances. In case any excess admission is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
- (f) That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any Indian and/ or Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining prior approval from AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
- (g) That the Institution shall not conduct any course(s) in the field of technical education in the same premises/ campus and / or in the name of the Institution without prior written approval of AICTE. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
- (h) The institution shall not conduct any non technical course(s) in the same premises/ campus under any circumstances. In case any violation is reported to the Council, appropriate penal action including withdrawal of approval shall be initiated against the Institution.
3. That the institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus, study centers/ extension centers, directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ university/ organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approval from the AICTE.
4. That the tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the Council from time to time. No capitation fee shall be charged from the student/ guardians of student, in any form.



- 5 That the accounts of the Institution shall be audited annually by a certified Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Council or any body or persons authorized by it.
- 6 That the Director/ Principal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures, qualifications and experience prescribed by the Council from time to time and pay scales are as per the norms prescribed by the Council from time to time.
- 7 (a) That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as desired by AICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards.  
(b) That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencement of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/ programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the form of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on cost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be put on the Institution Website. The information shall be revised every year with updated information about all aspects of the institution.  
(c) That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a Website providing the prescribed information. The Website information must be continuously updated as and when changes take place.  
(d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosures on fulfillment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within the time limit prescribed by the Council from time to time **i.e. 31<sup>st</sup> August 2009 for the current year.**  
(e) That if Technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/ or misrepresent the information, appropriate action could be initiated including withdrawal of AICTE approval.
- 8 That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabi of the concerned affiliated University and shall be in operational condition before making admissions.
- 9 That a library shall be established with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian & Foreign) etc as per AICTE norms.
- 10 That a computer center with adequate number of terminals, Printers etc. shall be established as per AICTE norms.
- 11 AICTE may carry out random inspections round the year for verifying the status of the Institutions, to ensure maintenance of norms and standards.
- 12 That the AICTE may also conduct inspections, with or without notifying the dates, to verify specific complaints of misrepresentation, violation of norms and standards, mal practices etc.
- 13 That the Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant in aid from the Central or State Government.
- 14 **That in the event of a student/ candidate withdrawing before the starting of the course, the wait listed candidates should be given admission against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) shall be refunded and returned by the Institution / University to the student/ candidate withdrawing from the programme. It would not be permissible for Institutions and Universities to retain the School/ Institution Leaving Certificates in original to force retention of admitted students (See Public Notice AICTE / DPG/ 03(01) /2008)**
- 15 The Institute shall take appropriate measures for prevention of ragging in any form, in the light of directions of Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition No. (C) 656/1998. In case of failure to prevent the instances of ragging by the Institutions, the Council shall take appropriate action including withdrawal of approval.




16 That the institution shall provide the following facilities for the physically challenged persons.

- a. Class rooms, toilets and hostels to be made accessible to wheel chair users.
- b. Resource room for visually impaired students.
- c. Accessible Library
- d. Counseling Centre for disabled students
- e. Facility of Sign Language Interpreter
- f. All students needing assistive devices to be provided such devices

17 That the Management shall strictly follow further conditions as may be specified by the Council from time to time.

18 In the event of non-compliance by the **Rajiv Academy For Technology & Management, NH-2, Delhi Mathura Road, Kota, P.O.Chhatikara, Mathura-281 001(UP)** with regard to guidelines, norms and conditions prescribed from time to time the Council shall be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval or recognition, without consideration of any related issues and that all liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would solely be that of **Rajiv Academy For Technology & Management, NH-2, Delhi Mathura Road, Kota, P.O.Chhatikara, Mathura-281 001(UP)**

WHEREAS in terms of Section 15 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **Rajiv Academy for Technology and Management, National Highway # 2, Mathura – Delhi Road, Post – Chhatikara, Mathura –281001, Uttar Pradesh** has submitted an application (code No. APN03636) to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for starting **M.Ed. Course** of One year duration with an annual intake of **25 (Twenty Five Only)** students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Secondary Teacher Education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition **Rajiv Academy for Technology and Management, National Highway # 2, Mathura – Delhi Road, Post – Chhatikara, Mathura –281001, Uttar Pradesh** for conducting **M.Ed. Course** of One year duration with an annual intake of 25 (Twenty five Only) students under clause 7(12) of Regulation dated 13-1-2006 subject to fulfillment of the following:

- (i) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Northern Regional Committee.
- (ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

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5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

**ORDER**

Rajiv Academy for Technology & Management, Milestone - 3 K.M., National Highway# 2, Delhi Mathura Road, Mathura - 280001 (U.P.) had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition for B.Ed. course of One Year duration from the academic session 2003-2004 with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred) students in terms of section 14(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the inputs received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- (a) The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- (b) The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above-mentioned land.
- (c) The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs. 5,00,000 (Rupees Five lacs Only) and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3,00,000 (Rupees three lacs Only).
- (d) The institution has initiated the process for recruitment of Principals / Head of Department and teachers for the said course.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Rajiv Academy for Technology & Management, Milestone - 3 K.M., National Highway# 2, Delhi Mathura Road, Mathura - 280001 (U.P.) for an intake of 100 seats (One Hundred) seats in B.Ed. course of one year duration with effect from the academic session 2003-2004 subject to fulfillment of the following before the commencement of the session.

- (a) Appointment of the faculty members duly qualified and staff as per the norms of NCTE/State Govt./ UGC is to be completed before the commencement of the session.
  - (b) The countersigned statement of all faculty members from the Registrar of the concerned University should be submitted before the commencement of the academic session 2003-2004.
  - (c) The institution shall adhere to all the other Regulations and Guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
  - (d) The institution shall within ONE MONTH of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a joint account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than SIXTY MONTHS (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank only (and not any other certificate) to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
  - (e) That the Reserve Fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the Teachers & staff be maintained, in the form of FDR in favour of the management / institution, for a period of not less than SIXTY MONTHS (Five years) in a Nationalized Bank.
  - (f) Non-compliance of above conditions as mentioned vide this Order of Recognition shall invite action under Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993.
4. The Recognition is subject to the condition that the affiliating University shall ensure that, among other things, the institution has appointed required number of faculty members (including Principal / Head of Department), as per the norms of the NCTE / UGC / Affiliating University.
5. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government, etc.
6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and/or order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
